Landlord Agreement for Tenant Participation in Opportunity Gardens

Your tenant has applied and been accepted to enroll in our garden mentor program, Opportunity Gardens, a program of Columbia Center for Urban Agriculture. This program provides people the means to grow some of their own food. CCUA employees, volunteers and your tenant will install the garden together, then your tenant will participate in ongoing mentoring at least 1 time per season for up to 3 years. They are expected by us to keep the garden weed free and watered and tended. In the winter we put down a layer of straw.

If your tenant moves within the 3 years of participating in our program, when we are notified we will remove the bed within 3 months of notification. After the 3 year period the tenant understands that they are responsible for removing the garden bed and reseeding the area.
